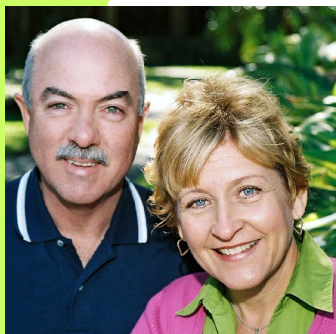

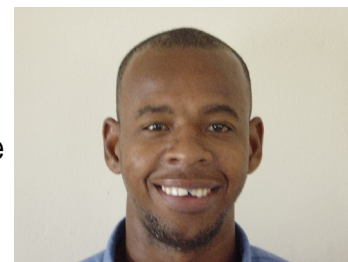

## Meet Adrian

As directors of the Assembly of God Bible Institute in Belize City, we have enjoyed meeting students and pastors from all over the country that are training to work as leaders and pastors in the churches of Belize.

*We want to introduce Adrian.* He is a new student this year and comes from an extremely poor background and what would seem impossibilities as far as the ministry is concerned...but he KNOWS that God has called him to preach! He has 80% deafness, but with a hearing aid he can hear some speech but he must SEE your lips to understand what you are saying. He is always smiling, happy, and talking about the ministry God has for him. He lives in a small room where he attends church. One day Tom was cleaning a workroom at the school and Adrian saw an old cot and asked "Can I have that?" Tom asked, "What do you need a cot like this for?" He answered, "Then I could have something to sleep on." He doesn't know how he will pay his tuition, but he KNOWS God has been faithful to him. Average tuition for a trimester is \$165, and there are three each year. If you want to help evangelize Belize, helping a student go to Bible School is one tremendous way. We have churches RIGHT NOW that have no pastors because there are none to fill that position. We want to plant more churches, but there has to be a pastor and many times it is just finances that prevents students from coming. Adrian is determined to follow the call that he knows God has placed in his heart! Helping fund a student is one of the best ways to spread the gospel in Belize. God is still leading young men and women to do His work!

Meet Jeffrey Trap! He is a pastor and teacher at the Bible Institute. It wasn't likely that he would ever be in the ministry. His mom left him and went to the U.S. when he was 2 yrs. old. He doesn't know who his father is. He lived with his grandmother until he was 10 yrs. old and left to live on the streets in Belize City...a very rough place. At 12 years old his grandmother turned him over to the court system to be placed in a home for boys. He was required to stay there until he

was 18. He never went to church and was only street smart...*but God had plans for him.* The boys from the boy's home had to jog everyday, but occasionally Jeffrey and another boy would stop running and hide in a church, which was usually empty. One day that is exactly what they were doing and they hid in the church, but on this day there was a pastor praying. He saw the boys, stopped praying, and asked them if they had given their lives to Jesus Christ. Jeffrey said right then

he felt the Holy Spirit like he never had and knew that was what he wanted and needed! He accepted Christ, worked through mountains of problems, went to Bible School, and is now a pastor and teaching at the Bible Institute, and has a precious family. God has plans for us! God has plans for YOU! God loves us so much that he even wants the unlovable, the unwanted, and those that others have forgotten. A simple prayer from an elderly pastor made the difference in his life!

## Bible Institute Projects

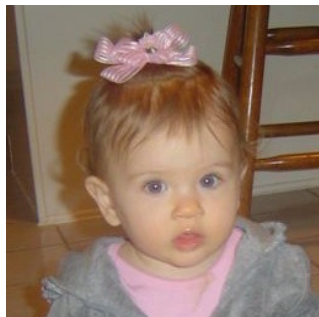
There are several things the Bible school really needs. If you see something below that could be a missions project for a Sunday School class or a church missions effort...these are three things we really need right now.
