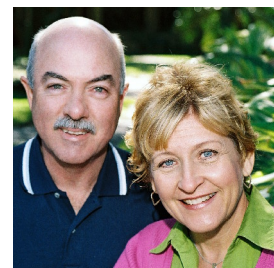

## LATIN AMERICA CHILDCARE...

*Sitting right on the river in Belize City* is one of the small grocery stores where we shop. As we arrived at the store a few weeks ago a small boy approached our car, not wanting to pass up the chance to ask for a dollar from a "gringo." Usually they tell you it is to buy school books but as soon as you give them a dollar, they run to a little shop nearby and buy a coke. Normally we don't give them money. This day was a little different. While I went in the store, Tom waited outside and began a conversation with the young boy, dressed in torn, dirty clothes. Tom visited with him and asked him some questions. He found out that he lives in a little house right on the river with nine brothers and sisters and their mother who works all day. These children are basically left to take care of themselves. He said he wanted some food, so Tom gave him a few dollars and thought he probably wouldn't see him again.

A week later we saw him again and found out his name was Justin, but this time he was in a school uniform. We asked him where he went to school and he said "Central Assembly of God School." We were instantly excited because this is a school that provides Christian education to some of the poorest children in Belize City. We know this child is receiving daily Bible lessons and weekly chapel. In the daily Bible lessons at school he is learning about the power of God that can give him a new life in Christ plus he has caring, Christian teachers. It is very probable that he doesn't even know who his father is. It is also probable that he can't complete his education because his mother can't afford to continue sending him to school and feed the other children also. We have a unique opportunity in Belize to reach Justin and other children just like him. By supporting a child through Latin American ChildCare of the Assemblies of God, you can help provide a child with hope and a future.

You can help us reach the children of Belize by sponsoring a student at one of our Assembly of God Christian Schools.
